This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.64 dated 03.03.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 380, 427 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 02.03.2017 (Annexure P-6).

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to decide the representation dated 02.03.2017 (Annexure P-6), by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
