Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been appearing regularly before the learned trial Court and only on one occasion, i.e. 17.2.2017, he did not appear, allegedly on account of the fact that he mistook the date, on which date his bail bonds were forfeited.

In the aforesaid circumstances, I see no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail. The petition is consequently dismissed.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and presenting an application for 'regular bail', if the aforesaid contention is found to be correct, it would be decided on the same date by that Court, on its own merits. If the contention of the petitioner is found to be incorrect, the application shall be disposed of on merits by the learned trial Court in whatever time frame it thinks appropriate.
