This order of mine shall dispose of two revision petitions bearing CRR Nos.73 and 74 of 2015 involving the same issue.

Today, the accused-revisionist has paid the remaining amount of ₹2,00,000/- in cash to the respondent-complainant, who is present in the court and the same has been accepted by him. In this way, the entire disputed cheque amount has been paid. The amount of compensation was also deposited before the first appellate court in the light of the authority of Hon'ble the Supreme Court delivered in ***“Damodar S. Prabhu v Sayed***

dispute and the offence stands lawfully compounded, both the revisions are allowed. Consequently, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 02.11.2012 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar, which was affirmed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge (Adhoc), Fast Track Court, Amritsar vide judgment dated 15.11.2014 are set aside and the accused-revisionist stands acquitted.

Revisionist is permitted to cancel the draft submitted before the first appellate court.
