As regards the specific query put by this Court, learned State counsel, again on instructions, submits that it has been enquired into that neither of the petitioners were earlier married nor are they in any prohibited relationship to each other.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to continue to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected within the four corners of law.
