ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.297 dated 02.11.2015, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 302 IPC subsequently added), registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, states that 05 out of 28 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is now listed before the trial Court for examination of remaining prosecution witnesses on 11.10.2017. She further states that every effort shall be made to examine the remaining witnesses as expeditiously as possible.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, she does not press this petition and the trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial.

In view of the statement of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, as the case was registered in the year 2015, trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
