In the instant writ petition, petitioner has assailed the order dated 6.11.2012.

Petitioner's is relating to extending the benefit of overtime of 4 hours on the score that he has discharged the duties of the post for 12 hours a day as on the date of his claim. BBMB issued a circular relating to payment of overtime wages/grant of compensatory leave to the employees in BBMB. Perusal of Para A (i) (a) which provides for extending benefit of extra hours @ twice his ordinary rate of wages as laid down under Section 59 of the Factories Act. The respondents are stated to have extended the benefit in terms of the circular dated 18.8.1988. The said circular was not placed before the Labour Court as is evident from Para 10 by either of the parties. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the

Labour Court award.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
