Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Notice of motion was issued on 21.03.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, submits that petitioner No.1 Rajveer Kaur is presently residing with her maternal uncle and FIR No. 42, dated 10.03.2017, under Sections 366, 366-A and 376 of IPC, was registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo against petitioner No.2. Later on, the matter was compromised and petitioner No.2 was acquitted.

Since, as per aforesaid submission of ASI Joginder Singh, petitioner No.1 is now residing separately from petitioner No.2, her maternal house, this petition is rendered as infructuous.

Dismissed as rendered infructuous.
