Petitioner-Rajni seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.549 dated 08.10.2015, registered under Section 306/34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak.

Complainant Mamta @ Heena got registered the FIR with the allegations that her marriage was solemnized with Harish about 10 years ago. No child was born out of the wedlock. Her husband was running a tea shop and she was doing a job in the private school. Complainant alleged some incriminating allegations of harassment of her husband at the instance of the petitioner and her husband Joginder.

Both the parties were called before the Women Cell,

Rohtak on 07.10.2015 and some altercation took place between them. After attending the proceedings before the Women Cell, Rohtak, the husband of the complainant allegedly consumed some poisonous substance and ultimately died.

As per prosecution, part attributed to the petitioner is that of abetting commission of offence as she was having illicit relations with the deceased.

At this stage, without adverting to the merits of the case and considering the petitioner to be a lady, having large family to maintain including one minor son aged about 1 year, who is with the petitioner in the Jail. This Court feels that benefit of regular bail can be given to the petitioner.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
