Petitioner-Tanuja has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.83 dated 27.02.2016, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, under Sections 21 and 27-A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the main accused has been apprehended with 18 grams of heroin. The present petitioner has been nominated in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-

accused. The allegation against the present petitioner is that the main accused, who was apprehended by the police, has bought the heroin from her.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.06.2016. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that recovery effected in the present case falls in the non-commercial quantity, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹35,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
