The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.182 dated 10.10.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 read with Section 109 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 17 read with Section 4 of POCSO Act and Sections 4, 5 of Prevention of Immoral Trafficking Act, registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has appeared before the trial court and furnished the bail bonds.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions

from Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has appeared before the trial court and furnished the bail bonds.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has appeared before the trial court and furnished the bail bonds, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 28.03.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
