Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 81 dated 27.10.2016, under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

In FIR No. 251 dated 26.10.2016 under the Arms Act, the petitioner allegedly made some confession, which ultimately

led to recovery of contraband in the present case. 648 intoxicant tablets were allegedly recovered. On analysis, the same were found to be containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride. The total weight of the tablets was assessed to be 50.0256 grams of Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride, which was marginally more than the commercial quantity.

The petitioner is in custody since 27.10.2016. He is not involved in any other case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

In case under Section 307 I.P.C. and under Arms Act, the petitioner is on bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh contends that the challan has not been presented so far.

In view of the aforesaid, without adverting to the merits of the case, it will be just and expedient to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.

Let the petitioner be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his furnishing heavy bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed

to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
