By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought blanket anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in any case/FIR to be registered against him by police of Police Stations of respondent Nos.2 and 3.

The learned counsel states that the petitioner has an apprehension that he can be implicated in a complaint filed by respondent No.4 with which the petitioner has no concern. He has been harassed by respondent Nos.2 and 3 under the garb of said false complaint.

Heard.

The grievance of the petitioner is that he is being harassed by respondent Nos.2 and 3 on the false complaint filed by respondent No.4.

However, a perusal of case file reveals that the petitioner has not moved

any representation or application for redressal of his grievance. In such circumstances, this Court feels that no case is made out to grant the relief sought.

Dismissed.
