The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.61 dated 25.04.2016, registered under Section 21 of NDPS at Police Station Shambu, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. In fact, no recovery was effected from the petitioner.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

As per the case of the prosecution, 400 gms of heroin was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The quantity recovered is commercial in nature. So, no ground is made out for grant of bail. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
