Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438, Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely Bashir in case FIR No.295, dated 15.12.2016, under Sections 5/13 (2) 17 of the *Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan & Gausamvardhan Act*, 2015, Sections 11-59-60 of Animal Cruelty Act and Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Mewant.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he was carrying cows for slaughtering in vehicle No.HR-55N-5488, LP Truck. On a secret information, the said truck was apprehended and four feeble cows were found loaded in the aforesaid truck. However, the petitioner and his co-accused succeeded to run away.

Vide order dated 08.05.2017, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation and granted ad interim bail subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC- Rakesh

Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and nothing has to be recovered from him.

In the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and interim order dated 08.05.2017 passed by this Court, granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
