**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.**

The allegations against the petitioner Fateh Singh in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that he along with his co-accused on 26.6.2016 assaulted the complainant Jasvir Singh while he along with his friend Mheshi Pehalwan were going on their vehicle bearing registration No.PB-10-ET-7809 and it is alleged that the petitioner along with co-accused were going on a car bearing registration No.PB-65-X-0149 and that one of the accused had fired hitting the complainant Jasvir Singh on the shoulder.

It is vehemently contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that neither the petitioner named in the FIR and it was subsequently, at belated stage his name has been cropped up and that the similarly placed co-accused Kulbir Singh has been allowed bail vide orders

dated 8.3.2017 of this Court.

The bail application is stoutly opposed by learned State counsel, who has readily accepted the factual scenario.

In view thereof and keeping in view the period of incarceration and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
