On 22.03.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegation against the petitioner is that he forwarded the report submitted by Ravi Sen without making any spot inspection. During Jatt Arakshan from 16.02.2016 to 24.02.2016, the intensity of agitation was such in the concerned area, it was not possible for the petitioner to do any physical verification at the spot. In case of co-accused Ramesh Kumar in CRM-M No.8572 of 2017, this Court has already issued notice of motion for 08.05.2017 with interim order.

Notice of motion for 08.05.2017.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.8572 of 2017.

Interim order in the same term as passed in CRM-M No.8572 of 2017. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagmit Singh. However, he submitted that recovery is still to be effected from the petitioner. Departmental proceedings are also pending against the petitioner.

Seeing the contents of the earlier order passed on 22.03.2017, I deem it appropriate to make the same absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so.
