This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 32 dated 02.04.2016 registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 22/61 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for 11 months and 02 days as per the custody certificate filed in Court today, with not a single prosecution witness examined out of eleven.

On specific query, learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, does not deny the aforesaid factual position and further submits that there is no other criminal case seen to have been registered against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that the recovery stated to have been made from the petitioner is of a marginally higher quantity than commercial quantity, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
