The petitioner prays for quashing of FIR No.74 dated 26.06.2016 (Annexure P1) registered at Police Station Nawanshehar Sadar, District SBS Nagar for offence punishable under Section 498A-IPC on the basis of compromise dated 06.03.2017 (Annexure P2), effected in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Perusal of the Clause (ii) of para 6 of the settlement dated 06.03.2017 would evident that petition for quashing of the FIR shall be filed after obtaining divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Counsel for the petitioner has fairly informed the Court that a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act is yet to be filed.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of being pre-mature but without prejudice to rights of the petitioner to file a fresh petition, in consonance with the terms and conditions of the compromise.
