The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to take appropriate action on the complaint submitted by the petitioner and against respondents no.4 to 9.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Even the complaint dated 25.5.2016 placed on record at Annexure P-3 and addressed to the S.S.P., S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali has been perused.

Apparently, the petitioner is running a concern by the name of M/s Jagdev Industries which is engaged in the manufacture of gates, grills, fabrication sheets, rolling shutters etc.

It is the contention raised in the complaint itself by the petitioner that he had received certain payments from the private respondents, who are functionaries and officials of Vodafone company.

Apparently, there appears to be a dispute between the parties with regard to a work order having been issued in favour of M/s Jagdev Industries.

While declining to interfere in the present petition, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of his remedies in accordance with law and in relation to any contractual obligations that he had entered into with the private respondents.
