Allegations against the petitioner Prince alias Mangoo in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail are that on 17.11.2016 he assaulted injured Mohan Lal with brick hitting him on the forehead.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is in custody since 19.11.2016 and that there is no medical evidence to support the applicability of Section 326 IPC.

Though the factual scenario could not be displaced by learned State counsel however, he has sought to oppose the grant of bail.

Appreciating the submissions, a debatable issue having been arisen as to the applicability of Section 326 IPC and that the petitioner is in custody since long time together with the fact that the trial will take a

long time to conclude, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
