Petitioners-Surinder Kumar and Ashok Kumar have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4 and further directing respondents No.2 and 3 to provide at least 10 days time while serving notice under Section 160 of Cr.P.C.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that representation dated 19.03.2017 (Annexure P-9), given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, by the petitioners be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2/Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-9) and pass appropriate order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
