This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to register the case against respondent No.4 and take appropriate action against him in accordance with law for committing fraud, cheating, criminal misappropriation and criminal breach of trust.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to consider and decide the representation dated 26.12.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to decide the representation dated 26.12.2016 (Annexure P-1), by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
