A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.532 dated 19.9.2016, under Sections 379-B(2), 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar. Learned Counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has to his credit three more cases of similar nature. Undoubtedly, the petitioner appears to be habitual offender in the matter of snatching. However, in this case, evidence has been recorded and I have gone through the evidence of PW1 Rahul Sethi – complainant/ victim, who has not supported the prosecution case. In that view of the matter, the petitioner has made out a case for grant of bail. Hence, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned, however, subject to furnishing an undertaking that the petitioner shall not indulge in similar or any type of offence and give attendance from 11 AM to 4 PM in the concerned Police Station. The police to have surveillance over the petitioner.
