By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.709 dated 19.08.2016, registered under Sections 407, 420 and 384 IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Distt. Karnal.

It is asserted that the allegation against the petitioner is that consignment of apples of which the petitioner is a transporter, did not reach the destination. Contends that allegedly Rs.2.5 lakh has already been recovered from the petitioner and to show his *bona fide*, he is ready to repay Rs.1.5 lakh within a week, subject to the outcome of the present FIR, to the complainant. Co-accused, Mohan Singh and Mahesh @ Naresh have been admitted to anticipatory bail and regular bail, respectively

by this Court.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel vehemently opposes the present petition and informs that challan has been presented and FSL report qua co-accused, Mohan Singh is yet to be received.

Heard.

Considering the above undertaking and the facts that co-accused, Mohan Singh and Mahesh @ Naresh, have already been admitted to bail and FSL report qua co-accused, Mohan Singh has not been received so far, no purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
