The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.330 dated 19.9.2016 under sections 323, 324, 325, 341, 201, 148, 149, 120-B I.P.C (section 308 I.P.C was added later on), registered at Police Station, City Sangrur, district Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that he would not be pressing for relief of bail for petitioner no.1.

As per submission made the instant petition qua petitioner no.1 Amritpal Singh Sekhon is dismissed, at this stage.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Prabhjot Singh in relation to an occurrence that took place on 17.9.2016. Main accused in the case is Amritpal Singh Sekhon and whose prayer for bail has not been pressed.

Petitioners no.2 and 3 herein are sought to be implicated on the disclosure statement of the main accused.

As per prosecution version, petitioner no.2 was allegedly armed with a baseball bat and inflicted injury on the wrist of Balwinder Singh and

which has been opined to be grievous in nature. In so far as petitioner no.3 is concerned, he is also stated to be armed with a blunt weapon and having inflicted injury on Prabhjot Singh and Karanvir Singh.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan already stands presented. Charges have been framed on 15.2.2017.

Trial, as such, is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

It has also gone uncontroverted that Sukhjinder Singh and against whom there are similar allegations, has been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order dated 14.3.2017, passed in CRM No. M-7424 of 2017.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed qua petitioners no.2 and 3. They be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.

Petition disposed of.
