The present petition is for regular bail on the ground that the petitioner is in custody since 8.8.2016 in FIR No. 589 dated 6.8.2016 under Sections 363, 366A IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that earlier the prosecutrix had made a statement before the Magistrate on 7.8.2016 that she had performed marriage with the petitioner at Arya Smaj Mandir and thereafter, on the asking of her family members, FIR was got registered against him and also most of the witnesses have not supported the prosecution version.

Learned State counsel contended that the material witnesses have since been examined and only some formal witnesses concerned with the investigation remains to be examined and, therefore, there is no ground to release the petitioner on bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the facts that; age of the victim is about 18 years; earlier she had made statement before the Magistrate that she has performed marriage with the petitioner; the petitioner is in custody since 8.8.2016 and the trial of the case is to take some more time, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.

The present petition stands disposed of.
