CRWP No. 2016 of 2013 is pending in which prayer is for release of the petitioner as per government instructions dated 08.07.1991 and for quashing of order dated 06.10.2010.

As per custody certificate submitted by learned State counsel, petitioner has already undergone 23 years, 11 months and 6 days of sentence inclusive of 3 years, 8 months and 2 days of remissions. The actual sentence undergone by the petitioner is 20 years, 3 months and 4 days as on 01.06.2017. The petitioner has already availed parole for 9 months and 10 days.

Petitioner was convicted for the offence under Section 302/376 IPC and was sentenced to undergo life imprisonment along with fine of Rs.10,000/-. The appeal was dismissed by the High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has already undergone the sentence as per policy dated 08.07.1991.

Without making any observation with regard to claim of the petitioner at this stage, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on parole till the next date of hearing on his furnishing personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Amritsar during pendency of the present writ petition.

Petitioner shall furnish an undertaking before the District Magistrate, Amritsar that he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and will maintain peace and tranquility in the area.
