misrepresenting himself to be Pargat Singh, approached the Manager of State Bank of Patiala, Branch Makhu, for a loan of Rs. 6 lakhs for purchase of harvester combine. The said Palwinder Singh produced the copy of jamabandi of said Pargat Singh. The said Palwinder Singh was identified by Lakhvir Singh (revisionist) in the bank to be Pargat Singh. Palwinder Singh accordingly mortgaged the said land, belonging to said Pargat Singh, vide mortgage deed dated 30.8.1999. Subsequently, Palwinder Singh failed to repay the loan amount and in inquiry, it came out that the jamabandi and khasra girdawari are the forged documents and impersonation was made by said Palwinder Singh.

I am of the view that the allegations are very serious. There is active participation of present revisionist in helping Palwinder Singh to misrepresent as Pargat Singh and obtain loan on the basis of forged jamabandi and khasra girdawari and execution of the mortgage deed. In these circumstances, it is not a fit case for reduction in the sentence. Hence, the present revision is dismissed. Let revisionist, who is stated to be in custody in some other case, be also taken into custody in this case to undergo the remaining part of the sentence.
