This revision has arisen out of an interim order passed in a petition filed under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short '**the Code**'). By interim order dated 1.4.2015, this Court had directed litigation expenses to be paid to respondent No.1-wife along with arrears of maintenance as assessed. Thereafter, the matter was referred to mediation and unfortunately the same remained unsuccessful.

On the last date of hearing, since there was no adequate representation on behalf of the parties, therefore, Ms. Payal Mehta and Ms. Supriya Garg were appointed legal aid counsel to assist this Court.

Today, it is informed that during the pendency of the proceedings in this Court, an ex-parte final order under Section 125 of the Code has been filed, which has now been challenged by the petitioner herein

to which reply has been filed.

In view of the fact that final order has already been passed in the petition under Section 125 of the Code, though ex-parte, this revision has been rendered infructuous. Dismissed as such.
