Vide order dated 19.05.2015, the petitioner was directed to pay additional amount of Rs.15,000/- towards litigation to the respondent-wife. Again on 16.02.2016, case was adjourned to 09.05.2016 in view of an undertaking by counsel for the petitioner to pay arrears of maintenance as well as Rs.15,000/- towards litigation expenses.

A relevant extract from order dated 17.10.2016 reads as follows:-

“By orders of this Court, the petitioner was directed to pay an additional amount of `15,000/- towards litigation expenses apart from paying arrears of maintenance. Several opportunities have been given to the petitioner to do the needful. However, the same has not been cleared to date.

A request is made today for adjournment on the ground that the counsel for the petitioner is not available. While adjourning the case, it is made clear that in case the said orders are not complied with, the criminal revision shall stand dismissed for non-compliance of the orders so passed.

Put up on 07.12.2016.”

Thereafter, on 07.10.2016, counsel for the petitioner prayed for another opportunity to comply with order dated 28.07.2015 and last

opportunity was granted for the purpose. As per report of the Registry, no deposit receipt has been received.

As the petitioner has failed to comply with directions of this Court despite umpteen number of opportunities granted for the purpose, the petition is dismissed.
