Heard.

The petitioner was arrested on 9.8.2015 and is in custody since then. The challan against him is stated to have been presented on 5.10.2016 and no witness has been examined so far. Petitioner has been declined bail by the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board on the ground that in the event of his being released on bail, he would come in association with other known criminals. The observations made by the

Principal Magistrate Juvenile is not specific or supported by any reasoning.

Keeping in view the period of custody the petitioner has undergone, the present revision petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of Juvenile Justice Board/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar subject to following terms:-

- a. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- b. During the period of his bail, he will remain under supervision of his parents or any other relative as per direction of Juvenile Justice Board, who will take care of his good conduct and appearance on each date of hearing.
- c. He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of Juvenile Justice Board.
