On 26.11.2015, the following order has been passed:-

“As per office report, service was complete on 7.8.2013. Neither the reply has been filed nor respondent No.1 has put in appearance. Respondent No.1 is proceeded *ex parte*.

For *ex parte* arguments, adjourned to 21.3.2016.”

Thereafter, the matter was listed on 22.08.2016, 16.09.2016 and 21.10.2016 but there was no representation on behalf of the respondents. Since respondent No.1 already proceeded *ex parte* vide order dated 26.11.2015, the matter has been heard.

The respondent-work-lady is stated to have worked as workman from 1996 to 2005, and she has also not rendered service of 240 days as recorded by the Labour Court, having served about 09 years, the labour Court has proceeded to award compensation of Rs.45000/-.

The petitioner has not made out a case so far as to interfere with the compensation of Rs.45000/- for the reasons that the respondent-work-lady had rendered service from 1996 to 2005. It was also noticed that the respondent-workman has not filed any writ petition against the award dated 28.01.2013. Therefore, the question of interference with the

award dated 28.01.2013 (Annexure P-4) did not arise since Labour Court has not passed the award of reinstatement, continuity of service, etc.

This writ petition stands dismissed.
