Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner presses the present revision petition only on the point of quantum of sentence.

Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. It shows that the petitioner has already undergone actual sentence of 9 months and 15 days including remission of 1 month and 24 days.

A perusal of the lower court file shows that the petitioner was driving a truck bearing registration No.RJ-13GA-8458 rashly and negligently and run over the cyclist Darshan Singh. After the accident, he sped away from the spot. The conduct of the petitioner in speeding away from the spot shows that he did not care for the cyclist Darshan Singh (now deceased). He was sentenced to undergo various rigorous imprisonments under different sections. The maximum sentence awarded to him is rigorous

imprisonment for one year for the commission of offence punishable under Section 304-A IPC. Therefore, there is no ground to reduce the sentence awarded to the petitioner.

Consequently, the present revision petition is dismissed.
