1. This order will dispose of CWP No.17555 of 2011 titled *Pardeep Kumar v. Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat and another* & CWP No.20005 of 2011 titled *Shish Pal v. Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat and another*.

2. On instructions from General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Karnal, the learned Law Officer states that this matter is indeed covered by

the judgments placed at Annex P-10 to P-12 with P-12 being the order of the Supreme Court dismissing Civil Appeal No.2180 of 2011 titled *General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Karnal v. Satish Kumar*. Satish Kumar has been successful in pursuit of the same relief and the present petitioners and Satish Kumar are admittedly identically placed with common dates of appointment and termination. Therefore, both petitions have to be allowed in terms of ruling in *Satish Kumar's* case (Supra).

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. As a result the impugned awards of the Labour Court are set aside in terms of the orders passed in the litigation which merged with the dismissal of the SLP in *Satish Kumar's* case. This would mean that the petitioners would have a right of reinstatement with 50% back wages as granted in *Satish Kumar's* case.
