Petitioners who are the convicts, undergoing the sentence for the offences under Section 376(2)(g), 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code move this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for grant of parole for 04 weeks under Section 3(1)(d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoner's (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for admitting their children in a school.

Reply was filed .

We also heard the submissions made on either side.

It is an admitted position that the applications submitted by these petitioners seeking parole for 04 weeks for admitting their children in school have not been disposed of by the respondent-authorities.
