Mr. Abhinav Sood, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the complainant and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Rule heard forthwith with consent of learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has also filed CRM-12245-2017 under Section 147 of Negotiable Instruments Act (in short, NI Act) for compounding the offence under Section 138 NI Act.

Learned counsel for the complainant made statement that indeed the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the complainant has been paid back his amount and is satisfied and does not want to continue with the prosecution against the petitioner.

Looking to the fact that the parties have settled the matter amongst themselves by way of compromise and the complainant is satisfied with the amount received by him, I do think that any further purpose will be served in continuing with the prosecution.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRM-12245-2017 and CRL. REVISION No.1349 OF 2017 are allowed.
- (ii) The judgments and orders dated 10.01.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala and 17.10.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, under challenge in this revision petition, are quashed and set aside by way of compounding/compromise.
