The petitioner has approached this court with a direction to the respondents to grant parole to the petitioner on the ground that the house in which his family is living requires repair.

As per report of the District Magistrate, Bulandshahr, the house did not require any repair. Father of the petitioner was merely 50 years of age. He and other family members could take care of the repair, if any required. About two years have passed when the petition was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh application for grant of parole, which may be considered on its own merits.

Learned counsel for the State does not have any objection to the prayer of the petitioner being granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty prayed for.
