Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

None is present on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondent despite second pass over. On 3.3.2016, this Court issued notice of motion only on the point of composition of offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. It was further ordered that let the petitioner bring a demand draft of the cheque amount along with compensation as per judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in Damodar S. Prabhu vs. Sayed Babalal H., 2010 (5) SCC 663.

Thereafter, several adjournments were granted. Petitioner did not comply with the said order nor has shown any inclination to compound the offence and pay the cheque amount.

It being so, the present petition stands dismissed.
