Preliminary arguments heard.

One stolen motorcycle bearing temporary registration No.PB-29E-7050 make boxer was recovered from the possession of the present petitioner at Majestic Chowk, Moga. Another co-accused, who was riding the pillion ran away from the spot. However, the present petitioner, who was driving the aforesaid stolen motorcycle was arrested but he could not give any satisfactory explanation for being in possession of the stolen motorcycle. The said motorcycle belongs to one Vikas Kumar and was stolen from the Court Complex, Moga.

After going through the judgments of both the courts below, I am of the view that recovery of stolen motorcycle from the petitioner is established. There is no illegality or infirmity in the judgments passed by both the courts below. The petitioner has been awarded rigorous imprisonment for 1 year in addition to fine.

Custody certificate dated 28.11.2017 of the petitioner has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. It shows that the petitioner has already undergone imprisonment for 1 year, 1 month and 4 days in another theft case. Another case is also pending against him. Therefore, there is no ground to reduce the sentence.

As such, the present revision petition is dismissed.
