Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

The present revision petition is directed against the judgment 14.1.2016, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana affirming the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 15.3.2014 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana, vide which, the present petitioner was convicted for commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and sentenced to undergo Simple Imprisonment for one year along with fine of Rs.3,000/-, in default of payment of fine, to further undergo Simple Imprisonment for one month.

The short prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is for reduction in the sentence while considering that the amount of cheque was Rs.45,000/- only.

After considering the facts and circumstances and the amount of the cheque, the sentence of Simple Imprisonment for one year is reduced to Simple Imprisonment for nine months. Remaining part of the sentence is maintained.

With the above noted modification, the revision petition is dismissed.
