Vide this common order, both these petitions i.e. CRR(F) No.137 of 2016 titled 'Vikas Chandra Vs. Shakun Chandra and others' and CRR(F) No.227 of 2016 titled 'Shakun Chandra and others Vs. Vikas Chandra' are being disposed of together.

CRR(F) No.137 of 2016 has been filed against the order dated 30.01.2016 passed by the District Judge, Family Court, Faridabad whereby petitioner-husband has been directed to pay maintenance to the tune of ₹ 70,000/-.

CRR(F) No.227 of 2016 has been filed by the petitioners (wife and children) seeking enhancement of the maintenance awarded vide order dated 30.01.2016.
