Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners – Dushyant and Kuldeep were admittedly juvenile on the date of offence. They seek regular bail in FIR No.721 dated 13.12.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 302, 325 IPC and 25/54/59-A of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Hodal. Trial has commenced and the complainant has been examined. I have perused the evidence against the other accused persons.
