**REKHA MITTAL J. (Oral)**

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the calculations prepared by the petitioner, he is in arrears of maintenance to the tune of Rs.25,000/-. He has further informed the Court that despite his repeated contact with the petitioner apprising him of the order dated 09.02.2017, the petitioner has not brought a demand draft of Rs.30,000/- nor is ready to pay outstanding amount of Rs.25,000/- as per his calculations with the plea that his salary has been attached by the Court below.

Without going into the correctness or otherwise of the calculations submitted by the parties, in view of the adamant attitude of the petitioner that he is not even ready to clear the arrears to the extent of Rs.25,000/- stated to be outstanding as per his own calculations, the petitioner is not entitled to be heard on merits of the case. The present petition, accordingly, fails and is ordered to be dismissed.
