Short affidavit of Satpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, on behalf of respondent filed in Court today and same is taken on record, in which it is reported that complainant Gurnam Singh as well as Bhupinder Kaur, wife of Sarwan Singh (deceased) have compromised with accused and the compromise is genuine.

On account of compromise, the learned counsel for revisionist prays for taking a lenient view in the quantum of sentence and presses the revision on quantum of sentence only.

Custody certificate dated 4.9.2017 filed in Court today and same is taken on record, which shows that revisionist has already undergone total sentence of 5 months 7 days including remission.

In view of the fact that the parties have compromised, but the offence is not compoundable, a lenient view in the sentence can be taken.

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As such, the sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year awarded under Section 304-A IPC is reduced to rigorous imprisonment for six months. The remaining part of sentence is maintained.

With the abovenoted modification, revision is dismissed.
