This is an application for permission to withdraw the present appeal on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties. It is further prayed that the compromise at Annexure A-1, attached with the application, be made part of the decree.

Notice in the application was given to the counsel for the respondents.

Counsel for the respondents does not dispute the contents of the compromise. He has also not opposed the withdrawal of the appeal by the appellants. Rather, it is admitted by him that the matter has been compromised between the parties, as per the terms and conditions, as mentioned in the compromise at Annexure A-1. He has also made a prayer that the compromise at Annexure A-1 be made part of the decree. These statements have been made by the counsel on instructions from their respective parties, some of whom are even present in the Court.

In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application, CM is allowed and the present appeal is permitted to be withdrawn in terms of compromise.
