(1) This order shall dispose of CWP No.15773 & 20243 of 2012. Both these writ petitions have laid challenge to the order dated 17.07.2012 passed by Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (in short, 'the Tribunal'). Vide the said order, the Tribunal accepted the claim of respondent No.1 who is a contractually appointed teacher. The petitioner – a deputationist from the State of Punjab having apprehended her repatriation approached this Court by way of instant writ petition. This Court granted interim protection to the petitioner as a result of which she is continuing on the post of Assistant Professor Economics in one or the other Government Colleges at Chandigarh.

(2) Mr. Suvir Sehgal, Sr.Standing Counsel, UT Chandigarh on the basis of written instructions dated 08.12.2017 received from the Directorate of

Higher Education, Chandigarh Administration informs that the petitioner as well as the first respondent are working against sanctioned posts and are drawing their salary regularly.

(3) Since the order dated 17.07.2012 passed by the Tribunal no longer affects the petitioner's continuation on deputation, the instant writ petition has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly, leaving the question of law open.
