Mr. K.P. Singh, IPS, Director General of Police, Haryana, is present in Court and submits that he could not file his affidavit in view of the fact that the order 14.03.2017 was actually not communicated to him personally.

However, as regards the issue in question, i.e. non-operation of the DDR/Roznamcha on the ground that the computer server or the computer itself is not functioning due to any mechanical or software problem, he has submitted that the issue with regard to the software problem is being sorted out which is actually a server issue, but in any case instructions are being issued to all police stations that in case the computer is not functional for any reason whatsoever, manual entry in the register to be maintained for the purpose, as was being done in the past, would be made, so as to ensure that there is no violation of either the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the Police Act or the Punjab Police Rules, 1934, and regular entries in the roznamcha are maintained as they are supposed to be.

That issue having been sorted out, since the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition itself, as recorded in the order dated 01.03.2017, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
