Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that though there are seven injuries shown on the person of the complainant, four of them are contusions, one is a laceration and one is a swelling on his neck.

However, learned State counsel has pointed out that the pain in the middle finger eventually turned out to be a fracture of that finger.

The petitioners are seen to have put in four months of actual custody out of the one year sentence imposed upon them by the trial Court,

upheld by the appellate Court, after conviction for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323 and 325 read with Section 34 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that they do not press the revision petition qua the conviction of the petitioners, if the petitioners are released for the remaining part of the imprisonment, on probation of good conduct.

The learned State counsel submits that if that is considered by this Court, it should be on payment of compensation to the complainant.

Consequently, upon the petitioners paying a total compensation of ₹ 30,000/- (₹ 15,000/- each), to the complainant, in addition to the fine of ₹ 1,000/- imposed upon them for the commission of each offence, they would be released on probation of good conduct for the remaining period of their sentence of imprisonment of one year, on bail and surety bonds to be furnished in terms of the Probation of Offenders Act, 1958.

Both the petitions are accordingly disposed of.
