The present revision petition has been filed challenging the order dated 10.4.2017 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panipat, whereby the application for additional evidence of the complainant has been allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner raised contention that the statement of witnesses were not relevant and still the Court allowed the application.

This plea of learned counsel for the petitioner is not tenable because the Court considered the statements of witnesses to be relevant and allowed to examine the said witnesses when the evidence was still going on.

There is absolutely no ground for revision of the order dated 10.4.2017 and accordingly, the revision petition is dismissed.
