Custody certificate dated 11.12.2017 filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

The allegations against revisionist are that he issue a cheque for Rs. 125000/-, which was dishonoured by the bank for want of sufficient funds.

On the last date of hearing, revision was pressed only on the quantum of sentence. As per the custody certificate, revisionist has already undergone total sentence of 6 months and 29 days, including remission, out of substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year. The custody certificate also shows that revisionist has been convicted in another case of similar offence by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda, on 3.5.2017 and another case of similar nature is pending against him.

Considering his previous record and amount involved,

substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year is reduced to rigorous imprisonment for nine months. Remaining part of sentence is maintained.

With the abovenoted modification in sentence, revision is dismissed.
